# Cleaning

Our staff will be cleaning throughout the day, following a scheduled routine. "High touch" areas will be cleaned frequently, following the guidelines shared by the Health Department & the state.

Staff will be teaching all students to wash hands thoroughly, with soap & water. Time will be scheduled throughout the day for students to wash.

Additionally, hand sanitizer will be available to all students in all classrooms.

# Screening

All staff and students will have their temperature checked daily. Those who ride the bus will have it checked before boarding the bus. All others will be checked before entering the building. Those students with a fever will not be allowed to stay.

Students who develop symptoms during the day will be quarantined until they can be picked up.

## Masks

All EHS students, while in the building, will wear masks at all times.

Families may provide one or the school will provide one.

Cloth masks need to be washed daily.

Students will get several "mask breaks" throughout the day.

Adults will wear a mask throughout the entire day.

## Learning "Your Way" with YOUR choice (grades 9-12 can opt to attend school IN PERSON or ONLINE)

### Face-to-Face instruction will be:

- Students may enter the building at or after 7:35am
- Students must enter school, go to their locker, and then immediately to their 1st hour
- Extended 1st hour (to eat breakfast in the 1st hour classroom)
- Extended passing times to insure rooms are cleaned in between each hour
- Extended 5th hour (to eat lunch IN the 5th hour classroom)
- Bus students will enter the building from the SOUTH EAST door (by Mr. Stein's room)
- All other students will enter the building through the main doors by the office

#### Online instruction will be:

- Taught LIVE (on Google Meet or Zoom), while the teacher is teaching students inside the classroom
- Families MUST fill out the survey that will be put out by the district to "OPT IN" to online learning
- Families will be able to transition back to face to face later, if they so choose, with advanced notice
- EPS issued Chromebooks are available for every EHS student
- AT&T hotspots are available upon request
- wo-way conversations (between teacher and student) twice per week, must occur
- Activities, graded assignments, etc. will be similar to or the same as what is offered in the face-to-face setting
