EMS Return to School Highlights

Masks

Students will have to wear masks while riding a bus, leaving their cars, or before they enter the building if they are a walker. They will also need to have a mask on when in classrooms, hallways or other common areas. This is a required element for all Michigan schools.

Students will not be required to wear a mask at recess or during PE class.

Staff members will wear a mask throughout the entire day.

Cleaning

Our custodial team will be cleaning throughout the day, following a scheduled routine. "High touch" areas will be cleaned frequently, following the guidelines shared by the Health Department & the state.

Staff will be teaching all students to wash hands thoroughly, with soap & water. Time will be scheduled throughout the day for students to wash.

Additionally, hand sanitizer will be provided to all students at daily entry points and in all classrooms.

Screening

All students will have their temperatures checked daily. Those who ride the bus will have it checked before boarding the bus. Car riders will have their temperatures checked before leaving the vehicle. Students who walk to school will be checked before entering the building. Those students with a fever will not be allowed to stay.

Students who develop symptoms during the day will be quarantined until they can be picked up.

Staff will be required to document a self-screening on a daily basis.

All students will be in "cohort classes" by grade level. Students will remain in their home groups throughout the day. Teachers will rotate to classrooms. Cohort groups will travel to their enrichment classroom.

Virtual learning will be provided by EPS staff for those families who choose to pursue this mode of instructional delivery.
