K-12 FACE TO FACE CLASSES RESUMING MONDAY, JANUARY 4, 2021

We are very excited that the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services order issued on December 18th, which is effective through January 15, 2021, allows in-person instruction for students in prekindergarten through grade 12. Our current offering of both face to face instruction as well as our remote learning option will continue. Hopefully, COVID cases will continue to drop and we will not be forced to close our schools for in-person instruction.

We have heard that some students who have been virtual learners first semester are planning on returning on Monday for face to face instruction for second semester. If you have not already contacted the principal of the building your child will be attending, we are asking that you call the office of that building and leave a message. The office numbers are as follows: High School 734-5551; Middle School 734-4222 and Elementary 734-5595. Although no one will be working after Wednesday, principals will be checking for messages. We certainly welcome and look forward to having your student back in the building.

MEALS AVAILABLE BEGINNING MONDAY, JANUARY 4TH

We will continue to provide meals for all children ages 0-18. If your child is attending face to face, an additional two days of meals (breakfast and lunch) will be available for pick-up. If your student is a virtual student, seven days of meals will be available. If you have other children ages 0-18 who are not attending Evart Public Schools, they are still eligible to receive the meals. Each Monday from 3:00-5:00 you may pick up the meals at the cafeteria door of the middle school located at the south end of the building.
