We have taken it off the website and will be sending a hard copy out to all families in the Friday mailings that are being sent out from each building principal. It is really, really important that you complete the form and send it to school with your child or drop it off in any building office including the Central Office. We must have this filled out by all families regardless if your students will be attending face to face or virtual. Remember you only need to do one form for a household. All students should be listed on just one form. Thank you so much for taking time to do this to ensure we will get all the state and federal funding our district is entitled to.

BUS PASSES

We will be unable to issue bus passes this year at least until we are able to relax some of the requirements that we must adhere to in Phase 4 of the Return to School Roadmap. Whatever stops needed for your child when school starts and you have confirmed these stops with our transportation department will be honored. We realize that there are students who have to go to one home on certain days or weeks and another home on the opposite days. We can make this work. All students will have assigned seats on the bus. Some students will just have assigned seats on two buses. For contact tracing it is extremely important that we know what seat a student was sitting in. I know this may cause some challenges for you but we must do everything we can to ensure the health and safety of all our students. Thank you for your patience and understanding as we continue to work through these challenging times.
