Breakfast and Lunch For ALL Students

We are very excited to announce that Evart Public Schools will be participating in the Community Eligibility Provision (CEP) program for the 2020-21 school year. What this means is that all students can receive a healthy breakfast and lunch at NO CHARGE for any student. However, to ensure that we do not lose any funding of other state funds that we use for social workers, counselors, aides and many other things, we need to have every single household fill out a Household Information Report. It does not matter if you know you would not qualify for free or reduced lunch, or if you normally would fill out the free lunch application, or if you usually receive a letter saying your child already qualified. This year is different – EVERY HOUSEHOLD MUST FILL OUT THE FORM. You only need to do one form for the entire household not for each student. All students living in the home are listed on the form.

The form is available on the district website at evartps.org. Please complete the form as soon as possible. If we do not get all the forms filled out and returned, we may lose some of our state and federal funding. If you have already filled out the form – thank you. You do not need to do it again.

Thank you in advance for taking the time to complete the Household Information Report. Your help in securing all the funding for our students that is available is greatly appreciated.
